Data Sources for Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program Eligibility




Eligibility Data Overview

The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) requires recipients and subrecipients to verify that a client meets three core requirements:

- HIV diagnosis
- Income at or below a set threshold for the household (usually based on a set percentage of the federal poverty level)
- · Residency in the service area

RWHAP recipients and subrecipients use a number of different sources of data—in addition to client attestation—to confirm these eligibility criteria. In many cases information can be matched across systems, such as Medicaid, Medicare, or other RWHAP medical care and eligibility systems.
